Each year, students and course instructors are able to recognize outstanding graduate student teaching assistants by nominating them for a Graduate Student Teaching Award. Twenty awards of \$500 are presented annually to graduate students. Award recipients are selected by the GSTA Committee based on the results of standard evaluations and written comments provided by nominees' students.
